Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to Room 13 and the third grade! I am looking forward to sharing a great school year with you. One filled with interesting experiences, learning and growth.

- 1) Just a reminder about **dismissal times**. We dismiss at **1:55** on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri. We dismiss at 12:55 on Wednesdays. THE FINAL BELL IN THE MORNING RINGS AT 7:45am. I will meet students on the intermediate side of the playground AT 7:42AM, in under the ramada. It is important to get to school on time. We start working as soon as we enter the school. 😊

- 3) I also write a weekly “Rosen’s Reporting” with all the news from Room 13 (and Henry). It will be sent home each Monday with your child. I also post this on the class website; you can download it from there too!
- 4) I will also be reaching out to you through Remind. It’s a great program that allows teachers to text easily with parents and families. I will be sending you an invitation soon. All you do is accept the invitation and we are set!
- 5) To start off this new school year there are certain supplies I would like your child to have:
 - a box of tissues (for our class supply)
 - markers (fine-line and broad, these are for their personal supply) I will also be providing some to start off the school year.
 - extra pencils
 - a colored pencil set (not necessary...but useful; again...personal)
 - a backpack or book bag to carry everything (no lost papers that way).
 - a small water bottle (it is HOT), if they use it as a toy...it will be taken from them. Please, no sports drinks while we are in class. They may drink them when we are on the playground.
 - some extra spiral notebooks
 - glue stick (for our class supply)
 - disinfecting wipes for our class supply
 - **A PAIR OF EARBUDS (I WILL PUT THESE IN A BAGGIE WITH YOUR STUDENT’S NAME ON IT. ONLY THEY WILL USE IT WITH THEIR LAPTOPS. YOU CAN PICK SOME UP AT THE DOLLAR STORE).** If they have headphones, these are fine too.

- 6) Our **lunch run** is from **11:45-12:20**. We will be having a snack in the mornings. Your child may bring in a healthy snack (NO CANDY). I will give out snack to those who did not bring one in. I have purchased some snack foods to start off the school year. If you can donate any health snack foods to our classroom supply, it would be greatly appreciated. I will ask for donations through the Rosen's Reporting. We need to keep the supply stocked for those hungry kids!
- 7) **Birthdays**: We are happy to celebrate birthdays in Room 13. You may send in treats for your child to share with the class. It makes it much easier on me if they are in individual portions to start with (for example: cookies, cupcakes, cookies, etc).
- 8) **OMA**: will be a little different this year. Mrs. Emily Evans will be our OMA AIS and will be working with the students twice a week. We might be learning to play recorders this year. More details to come later.
